Learning Objective:

Using Hul'q'umi'num',

- Students will learn terms for the nature of the river.
- Students will create actions to describe the nature of the river.
- Students will be able to learn and perform a song, using actions (TPR).

Materials needed:

- Vocabulary list
- Chant/song/sheet
- Visuals
- Musical instrument (optional)
- Props: water, ear, landscape
- Two dimensional visuals/ pictures
- Water props
- Set of directions in Hul'q'umi'num'

Activity:

- Give instructions in Hul'q'umi'num' to students.
- Vocabulary List : Teacher models pronunciation.
- Teacher will use the "I do, You Do, We all do....Sequence.
- Repeat until students are confident.
- Teacher will model the song and emphasize rhythm.
- Teacher will use the "I do, We all do....Sequence.
- Students will practice the song using actions.
- Teachers will have students practice and perform in small groups.

Assessment:

- Teacher Observation: Note student participation and proficiency.
